






# Perception Change after Visiting Japan
















Q30. What do you think current relations between South Korea and Japan are like? (%)


Q31. Do you think the ROK-Japan relations are currently important to South Korea? (%)













# Japanese Government's Attitude Toward Mutual Relations


Q36. How do you evaluate the current Japanese government's attitude toward improving the ROK-Japan relations? (%)

















Q43. What do you think about the direction of the ROK-Japan security cooperation, in response to the rapidly increasing nuclear and missile threats by North Korea? (%)










